



Sayers Engineering Spamount Hillclimb 2017

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS NO 1

1. Thank you for your entry which has been accepted. Please check our website www.omaghmotorclub.com for your competition number.
2. To avoid congestion in the paddock please approach the hill from Spamount village. For those approaching from Omagh turn right following the signpost for Victoriabridge/Castledearg which is 12.5 miles after the last roundabout on the Omagh Ring Road. For those approaching from Strabane turn left at the signpost for Victoriabridge/Castledearg which is 3.0 miles after the last roundabout on the Strabane Ring Road. In Victoriabridge follow the signpost for Castledearg. After 5.3 miles turn left at the signpost for Spamount. The paddock is on this road (Drumnabey Road) after 0.7 miles.
3. SCRUTINY & Sound Testing will take place between 8am and 9.30am on Saturday 27th May in Gareth Sayers' Yard which is within the paddock area on the Drumnabey Road, Spamount. Vehicles will be checked for conformity with MSA regulations with regard to safety and general eligibility for the event. MSA logbooks should be available for inspection where appropriate. Scrutiny will be under the control of Cyril Hughes and team.
4. DOCUMENTATION will take place immediately following vehicle scrutineering and will involve the collection of a satisfactory vehicle scrutiny sheet, the inspection of licences, signing of declarations and club membership.
5. The following amendment has been made to the Supplementary Regulations;

6. If applying for a non-race National B licence on the day please bring along a passport size photograph. It would also be helpful if you download a licence application form from www.msauk.org and complete it beforehand.
7. Trailer parking may be available in a field close to the Scrutiny venue. If this is the case please make use of the facility in order to reduce the length of the paddock which will help with the smooth running of the event.
8. A Driver's Briefing will be held at the startline around 10am
9. In order to maintain a good relationship with the local residents a speed limit of 30mph on the return road and 15mph in the Paddock area must be maintained. Anyone exceeding this speed or driving in an irresponsible manner may be excluded from the event. In the interests of maintaining a good relationship with the local community please do not litter.
10. The prize-giving will be immediately after the event at the startline. Please make an effort to attend if you are a prizewinner.
11. A catering facility will be available in the paddock area.
